

## **Report on the general assessment of needs in Dahieh**

## **Bir Al Abed Report**

- Concerning the damage mapping there is no count or statistics about it.
- There are water problems and nobody is taking care of it.
- There are bad smells in Bir Al Abed due to dust and Gun Powder related to bombing.
- There is no Drinking water nor non-drinking water for usage because apparently the water can't be used in the area (Reasons not known).
- The government electricity is available for 4 hours.
- There are Public diseases and symptoms such as allergies, vomiting and diarrhea. Apparently there is no medical team helping to solve such a problem in the area.

## **Borj Al Barajneh Report**

- The Population in Borj Al Barajneh is 350,000 including the Palestinian camp in the area. Without the camp it's about 330,000.
- Number of damaged buildings is 30. Number of destroyed buildings is 30.
- There are bad smells in Borj Al Barajneh due to garbage, gun powder from bombing as well as the smell of dead bodies. Apparently Sukleen is taking care of the problem.
- There is no drinking water. They have to buy the water.
- There is no non-drinking water for usage because of the source (reason not known) they have to buy.
- The electricity is available 12/24.
- There are psychological problems but statistics are still under study. There is no help to cure the cases.
- There are safe areas for gathering and playing. They said we can use the Rowais High School.
- There are women committees related to Hizb Allah that take care of women issues. Contact info is Khadija at the phone number 03/316869.
- Some people lost their jobs because of the war. Mojama3 El Hassan that provides work for 150 people was destroyed.

## **Ghobayreh Report**

### **Ghobayreh Municipality including Cheyah:**

- There are 7 destroyed buildings and 5 damaged.
- There is 1 damaged school.
- There are bad smells in Ghobayreh because of chemical material and dust. No one is taking care of the problem.
- There is no drinking water (the source is the government water). The reason for the absence of water is pollution.
- There is non-drinking water for usage. Source is the government water.
- The electricity is available between 4 and 6 hours per day. There exist a motor (echterak).
- There exist medical teams that are helping formed of Civilian Groups and Ghobayreh Municipality. They are providing medical checkups and vaccinations.
- There are psychological problems. Concerning women they have nervous breakdowns. Man have high pressures, children are afraid of loud sounds and bored. As for the youth they are bored also and thinking of immigration. There are groups helping to cure the cases formed of Ghobayreh Municipality, Civilian Groups, and a doctor called Adnan Kanj. The kind of service they offer is transportation to the hospitals.
- There are no areas for playing and gathering because of increase in population. They said we can use the CIS playground, and the football field. (not sure if for free or not).
- There are woman committees that are taking care of woman. They took care of 250 girls. The committee manager name is Ghazwa Farhat. Her phone number is 03/741275.
- There are groups that work with woman such as Al Nahda El Ejtema3ya and Doctor Alaweya Haydar.
- The role of woman after the war is limited by helping neighbors and friends as well as providing food for the volunteers.
- The woman committee manager is Ghazwa Farhat can be contacted at 03/741275. They supply medicines, help old people and orphans and provide supplies.
- Current woman problems are economical problems and social as well as being afraid on the future of their children concerning schools.

**Cheyah:**

- There are 2 destroyed buildings and 5 are damaged.
- There are bad smells in Cheyah due to garbage. Apparently the municipality of Ghobayreh is taking care of the problem.
- There is no drinking water. Regarding the non-drinking water for usage it is available 2 times per week and 6 hours per day.
- The government electricity is available for 6 hours. There are motors (echterak).
- There are some public diseases and symptoms such as diarrhea. However there exist medical teams that are providing doctors and clinics.
- There are psychological problems. The statistics available are for men only. It seems they suffer from nervousness. There is no help to cure the cases.
- There are areas for playing and gathering. They said we can use the Tayuneh garden.
- Some people lost their jobs because of the war. Apparently 4 shops are completely destroyed and some are damaged.

## **Hay El Sellom Report**

- There are water problems but apparently no one is taking care of it.
- There are waste water tunnel problems but also no one is taking care of it.
- There are bad smells in hay el sellom because of garbage. But apparently no one is taking care of it.
- There is no drinking water but the reasons are unknown.
- There is non-drinking water for usage. The source is the Mosque(jemi3).
- The electricity is available according to the government electricity schedule.
- There are public diseases and symptoms such as diarrhea and nosiness.
- There are medical teams that are formed of Amel doctors. They offer free treatments and medicines.
- There are psychological problems. Statistics are only available for woman. Apparently they suffer from nervous breakdowns. There exist units that are helping to cure the cases.
- There are woman committees that take care of woman issues. Mainly there concerns are social ones. The committee manager name is Doctor Ali Bazzi.

## Ouzai Report

- There are 7 destroyed buildings including 1 factory.
- There are bad smells in Ouzai because of the garbage. They consider it as a big problem. No one is working on solving the problem.
- There is no drinking water. They are using water wells.
- There is no non-drinking water for usage because of the ouzai situation. They are using water wells.
- The government electricity is available 2 to 3 hours. Some said it's available for 12 hours.
- There are public diseases and symptoms are allergies especially next to the bombed areas.
- There are areas for gathering and playing such as the Ahed football field.
- There exists woman committees that take care of woman issues like Jam3eyat Al Chabat Al Moslimat.
- Some people lost their jobs because of the war. 800 families used to work in the Mina in addition that 400 fishing boat were destroyed.

## Mouawad Report

- There are 12 destroyed buildings and 10 damaged ones.
- There are 4 damaged clinics.
- There is 1 damaged Nursery.
- There is 1 damaged social center.
- There are water problems but apparently some said no one is taking care of the problem others said that the problem is being fixed while fixing the damaged buildings.
- There are waste water tunnel problems but no one is taking care of it.
- There are bad smells in Mouawad as a result of gun powder, garbage, dead bodies, and dead animals. Sukleen is taking care of the problem as well as Jihal Al Binaa, Majles Al Inmaa Wal I3mar, and groups that belong to Hizb Allah.
- There is drinking water from Beirut water and others buy. Some said that there is no drinking water because the water is filtered only.
- There is non-drinking water for usage. The source is from Beirut water and they buy.
- The electricity is available between 4 and 6 hours. Others said it's between 8 and 12. They have motor (echterak).
- There are public diseases and symptoms such as viruses, fever, diarrhea, and allergies.
- There is a medical team that belongs to Hizb Allah. Apparently they are covering everything.
- There are psychological problems. For women they suffer from nervous breakdown. For men they suffer from fear and madness. The children are afraid from loud sounds. As for the youth they are bored. However there is no one taking care of the problem because the priority is for fixing the damage.
- There are no places for gathering and playing because of the destruction, however they are able to provide areas if we want.
- There are woman committees that takes care of women issues. The kind of work is related to the psychological war and cleaning related to the destruction.
- The role of women is positive as they are saying. They are contributing in the cleaning related to destruction as well as "supervising".



## **Mrayjeh Report**

- There are water problems but no one is taking care of the problem.
- There are waste water tunnel problems but also no one is taking care of the problem.
- There are bad smells in the area as a result of garbage, smoke, and bullet powder. Sukleen and Hizb Allah are taking care of the problem.
- There is drinking water provided by Hizb Allah.
- There is non-drinking water for usage from the water wells and the water company. Some said there is no water because of war.
- The electricity is available between 4 and 8 hours. There is motor (echterak).
- There are public diseases and symptoms such as diarrhea, nosiness, and bronchitis.
- There exist medical teams that are helping most of them are clinics that are related to Hizb Allah and Haraket Amal.
- There are psychological problems. There is help to cure the cases from the Hizb Allah.
- There are areas for gathering and playing, but not mentioned.
- There are woman committees that takes care of women issues. One of them is Al Zahraa, the manager is Ifat Amar and can be contacted at 03/453000.

## Sfer Report

- There are water problems and the water company is taking care of it by fixing the pipes.
- There are bad smells in the area because of the garbage and dead bodies. The volunteers are taking care of the problem.
- There is no drinking water because the source is salty and filtered only. They are buying water.
- There is non-drinking water for usage. They buy the water.
- The electricity is available between 2 and 4 hours. They have motor (echterak).
- There are public diseases and symptoms like viruses in the eyes and stomach as well as vomiting. There is no help to cure the cases.
- There are psychological problems, mainly nervous breakdown at the women's side. There exist help to cure the cases from groups that belong to Hizb Allah.
- There are areas for playing and gathering because there is a football playground. Some areas are destroyed because of destruction.
- There are groups that work with women, mainly Hizb Allah.
- The role of women is positive at the level of financial help. Some said there role is like men.
