Request for Proposal Submission For Insurance Offer for Norwegian People's Aid Lebanon Offices

Dear Sir/Madam,

Norwegian People's Aid (NPA) Lebanon is an International Non-Governmental Organization that has been working in Lebanon since 1982 on the basis of solidarity, Unity, Human Dignity, Equality, Democracy, and equal rights for all regardless of gender, race, religion, age, or social status.

Currently NPA has two programmes; Development and Humanitarian Disarmament. The development office is based in Beirut and starting out with emergency relief, physical rehabilitation and vocational training to improve the living standard of Palestinian refugees and other impoverished Lebanese. Today the program also focuses on support to local organizations promoting the rights of the Palestinian refugees and especially vulnerable groups, the rights of women and youth to participate, and combating violence against women. NPA continues to advocate for a solution for the refugees on the basis of UN Resolution 194.

In 2001, NPA started its Mine Risk Education / Mine Victim Assistance Program following the liberation of South Lebanon. This program aims at raising the awareness of affected communities on the danger of mines and UXOs and assisting the victims resulting from these weapons. More recently, NPA became involved in cluster clearance In Lebanon after the latest war in 2006. The conflict only lasted 33 days, however, more than 1 million cluster bombs were dropped over Lebanon and close to 300 civilians have been killed or injured by cluster bombs since. Clusters occupy large portions of arable land and NPA Humanitarian Disarmament removes these clusters in order for there to be a free and unhindered movement of people and productive use of land. The Humanitarian Disarmament office is based in Tyr.

Terms of Reference Health and Life Insurance Development and Humanitarian Disarmament Offices

General Instructions:

Norwegian People's Aid Lebanon is pleased to invite Potential service providers to express their interest in the provision of Group Medical Insurance Policy Coverage for NPA employees and their dependents in Lebanon.

Detailed Terms of Reference are mentioned below; The TOR as well as the Staff Annex List will form an integral part of the contract between Potential Service Providers and NPA Lebanon.

Insurance Companies that are invited to submit a proposal for Norwegian People's Aid request for insurance should take note of the following:

- 1. Description of the Insurance Company and its experience in providing similar services (not more than 2 pages);
- 2. The Insurance Company should guarantee that the quoted price per person per month in the financial offer stays the same in the frame between 100 -150 persons insured. In case that the number of staff insured falls outside of this bracket, the insurance company and NPA can renegotiate the price;
- 3. Insurance Company submitting the offer are bound by their proposals for 30 days after the deadline for the submission of offers;
- 4. Deadline for offers submission is <u>13 October 2014</u>; taking into consideration that the new policy will start on the 1st of November 2014;
- 5. Offers are to be submitted in English; and should be in two parts: Financial Offer as per the form attached, and Technical Offer based on the offer each company will present to NPA;
- 6. The below details are to be considered as minimum requirements, without any changes in the insured amounts and coverage periods requested;
- 7. Any additions/exclusions needs to be clearly described;
- 8. The Insurance Companies should bear in mind that due to budget restrictions, Norwegian People's Aid might not be able to cover all of its staff dependents; please refer to point 2 mentioned above for the number of staff; therefore might insure only it's staff members.
- 9. The Insurance Companies should bear in mind that the evaluation process is confidential and will remain internal and for NPA use only and might be communicated to NPA donors and auditors Only;
- 10. If this process will be canceled, for any reason whatsoever (no qualitative or financial worthwhile offers were received, Force Majeur, Financial offers are beyond NPA financial capacities), the Insurance Companies shall be informed in writing about this cancellation;



- 11. The successful Insurance Company will be informed in writing that its offer has been accepted;
- 12. Any Company that might seek to arrange individual meetings with NPA may be excluded from this process;
