Call for Participants Training of Facilitators on the Sustainable Development Goals Streamlining

About Aie Serve

Aie Serve is a youth-led, youth empowerment NGO established in 2007 with the core values of Respect, Acceptance, and Love. We believe in the model of empowering youth, acting as an enabler, for them to serve and develop their local communities. We have several programs operating for more than 12 years: Aie Clubs, Aie Consult, Aie Skills, Aie Power and Aie Exchange. We have implemented small projects that lasted between a few months to more than a year. Some of them include youth capacity-building workshops, camps and Training of Trainers (ToT), assessing and consulting youth on establishing or enhancing their own NGOs, youth exchange programs, youth mental health-related programs, youth economic empowerment (employability, upskilling, and entrepreneurship), among others.

About the Project & Scope of Work:

Aie Serve is developing a guide for youth-led NGOs to support them in becoming more streamlined with the SDGs. For that, it is designing a short 4-hour online training for youth facilitators (aged 18 – 30) who have some prior training or facilitation experience to be trained on the guide and support Aie Serve in coaching 5 youth led NGOs as a pilot project before rolling out the guide for general public use.

The training will target having around 10 youth facilitators, which will then be put in teams of 2, each coaching 1 NGO in their SDG streamlining efforts using the guide developed by Aie Serve.

Participants who successfully complete the training and coaching of the selected NGOs will be remunerated \$300 as an incentive fee.

Phases:/Procedure

- Phase 1: Call for Applicants (February 1 – February 10)
- Phase 2: Shortlisting & Selection of Facilitators (February 10 – February 20)
- Phase 3: Selected Applicants Informed & Training Dates Set (February 20 – February 22)
- Phase 4: 4-Hour Online Training Workshop (February 28)
- Phase 5: Assignment of Facilitators to NGOs (First week of March)
- Phase 6: Facilitators Coach Selected NGOs (Throughout March)
- Phase 7: Evaluation & Closure (April)
