#### • Subject of the call:

The Association for the Protection of Jabal Moussa is seeking a qualified contractor who has a verified experience in executing "Béton brut" constructions for the execution of its Tourism and Archaeological Center at the entrance of Jabal Moussa Biosphere Reserve in Qehmez. *The concept of the center is below.* 

The total surface of the center will be 550 sqm, and will include 3 floors:

- on the first level; an exhibition area.
- on second level: a conference room;
- on third level: a space to welcome visitors;

Works are expected to start in Spring 2022 and to last 6 months.

#### 2. Terms of Reference:

## The main responsibilities and duties of the contractor are the following:

The contractor is expected to work in close cooperation with APJM team and the supervising architects, to execute the below tasks.

- 1. Executing the construction works, following the architect's plans and a set a timeline.
- 2. Determining and procurement of material and equipment.
- 3. Meeting any regulatory and legal issues related to the construction
- 4. Doing the works, and establishing effective communication between the partners to report on project progress and arising issues.

## Language of the Contract, Reports and Communication:

The language of the contract and of all written communication, between the contractor, the supervising architect and APJM, shall be English.

- At least 10 years of experience in building contracting, with a verified experience in executing "Béton brut" constructions
- Mandatory: previous experience in similar projects.
