Role Summary

The IT Specialist will be responsible for several aspects of the program such as updating and configuring tablets to ensure the successful implementation of activities.

Main Accountabilities

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Install system updates and configure tablets at the project schools.
- Install the learning software "Tabshoura" and "Lalmoudares" on every tablet
- Ensure proper access to the "Lalmoudares" website on every table and register students.
- Ensure proper internet connection by connecting the tablets to routers equipped with internet bundles, guaranteeing the successful execution of the activities.
- Based on our experience, the update per tablet should take a maximum of 3 hours and there will be up to 20 tablets per school
