1) Background

3) Scope of Work

- Technical Expertise on a sectoral basis (e.g.: Agriculture, Industry, Tourism...)
- · Other business productivity areas

4) Qualifications and Eligibility Criteria

Qualifications:

- · Demonstrated experience in capacity building of SMEs as part of private sector development programs
- Experience providing consulting and/or coaching support to SMEs in Lebanon
- · Experience working with SMEs across sectors and Lebanese regions

Eligible organizations:

- · The organization must be a registered Lebanese entity
- · The organization has been operating for at least 2 years in the provision of BDS services
- Private sector companies (e.g.: consulting and training firms)
- · Chambers of commerce and/or business associations providing technical assistance to SMEs
- NGO s and nonprofit organizations with relevant technical and project implementation experience targeting SMEs

5) Financial Component

Applying BDS providers are requested to provide an indicative pricing proposal including fees for technical assistance interventions, coaching and group training sessions. This would be done by providing information concerning the cost of:

- a) A specific technical intervention
- b) The average daily rate of the consultants or staff members

6) Instructions for EOI application / proposal

a) Past performance:

Interested BDS providers are required to present in a table format the following information regarding past performance by providing the following details concerning at least 5 projects targeting small businesses:

- a) Project / contract name
- b) Client name (Funder when applicable)
- c) References (Name, position, email and telephone number)
- d) Contract value in USD
- e) Description of implemented activities
- f) Timeline of contract delivery (Start and End dates)

In addition to the table, kindly provide an Executive Summary describing each project intervention (1-page limit)

b) Team and staffing structure:

Applying BDS providers need to include their staffing structure in their application (number of full time and part time employees). In addition, companies have to provide the CVs of full time and contractual team members. The CVs must clearly state the sectoral/technical expertise, and each is restricted to a 2-page limit. Where applicable, providers must include contractual arrangements regarding their outsourcing needs / consultants.

c) Administrative requirements:

BDS providers are required to include the following information:

- Owner name
- Board of Directors (if applicable)
- Partners (if applicable)
- Company profile
- Company / Entity address and contact details Copy of Commercial Circular
- Copy of Ministry of Interior permit (if applicable)
- Ministry of Finance Registration number VAT Registration number (if applicable)

d) Submission requirements:

- Deadline for submission is Thursday May 31st 2018 close of business
