Long-Term English Program

Overview

Qualified Fulbright applicants who need to enhance their English language skills may be nominated to participate in a Long-Term English (LTE) program before the start of their Fulbright academic program.

Important Information

- You must first apply to the Fulbright Program in order to be nominated for the LTE Program.
- The Fulbright Program will inform eligible candidates.
- LTE programs are 6-8 months in duration and begin in January and March.
- Dependents cannot accompany LTE participants.

- Live and study on a U.S. university campus
- Receive full tuition and monthly living stipend
- Increase TOEFL score and chance of U.S. university admission
