- The tenderer shall indicate the estimated lead time for the delivery of the requested medical equipment.
- The tenderer should be a registered company in their country and should provide the GRC with a list that includes at least 2 references for similar orders to the region of delivery over the past 2 years with supporting documents as proof of that.
- The tenderer must respect conventions on freedom of association and collective bargaining, elimination of forced and compulsory labor, elimination of discrimination in respect of employment and occupation, and the abolition of child labor. For this, the tenderer should sign the certification that can be found attached.

The German Red Cross (GRC) is inviting quotations for the provision of Medical Equipment as part of its support to the Syrian Arab Red Crescent. The medical equipment will be distributed to the local community based on their detected needs.

The tenderers are requested to read carefully and ensure compliance with all instructions herein. By submitting your quotation, you indicate that you have received, understood, and accepted the "General Conditions and Remarks" mentioned above and the following specific "Instructions for submission of quote".

Non-compliance with instructions in this document may disqualify the bidders from the tender exercise.

1. Procurement Procedure

- 1) The procurement is handled via an open procedure.
- 2) The award will lead to a Purchase Order by GRC HQ Berlin and forms as a one-time-service.

2. <u>Deadline of submission and period of validity:</u>

- 1) Deadline of submission of quote and samples is **25 October 2022 at 12.00h Beirut time** the latest.
- 2) Your quotation must state the period of validity, at least 90 days from the deadline for the submission.

3. Costs and ownership of tenders

- 1) Costs incurred by the tenderers in preparing and submitting the quote requests are not reimbursable.
- 2) The GRC retains ownership of all quotes received under this quote request. Consequently, tenderers have no right to have their tenders returned to them.

4. Content of tenders and alternative offers

- 1) All tenders submitted must comply with the requirements in the tender documents and comprise of:
 - All pages of the tender must be stamped and signed by the supplier.
 - Company Registration Certificate.
 - Specifications of quoted items including any documentation required as indicated in the technical specifications
 - Financial offer and payment conditions.
 - Earliest delivery; transport conditions (e.g., Incoterms)
 - At least 2 credentials for previous similar services
 - Tenderers self-declaration (See Annex: "Declaration of Conformity") signed and stamped.
 - Due diligence annex signed and stamped. (See Annex: Due Diligence Check)
 - Registration documents including the VAT registration and other supporting documents.

- 2) Alternative offers are permitted and must be marcked as such.

5. Financial offer

- 1) Tenderer must quote by item.
- 2) Item price, inspection charges and transport charges are itemized separately in the financial offer.
- 3) All prices are in USD clearly indicating whether VAT is inclusive or exclusive.

- 3) GRC reserves the right to continue further communication after submission of quotes via a combination of media (e.g., post, e-mail, phone).

7. Samples, Evaluation & Award of Contract

The samples must include all items on the content list specifications.

2) The decision for the award of contract will be determined via standard value method (Credit points divided by total price; ratio 50/50%). Credit points will be added up through the following criteria (100%): quality of samples (50%), payment terms (10%), delivery schedule (25%), previous experience (15%). Score for each criterion is either:

0: Inacceptable - leads to exclusion

1: Bad → 10: Excellent

In case of equal results, the offer with the higher credit point score will be awarded.

Other criteria which may lead to exclusion, if not fulfilled:

- Ouotation must be stated in USD
- No advanced payment

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3) The GRC may – but is not obliged to - ask each tenderer individually for clarification of its quote including samples, breakdowns of prices etc. within a reasonable time limit to be fixed by the evaluation committee. The samples will remain property of the GRC. The tenderer must bear possible additional costs for a sample delivery.

8. Terms of contract

The award will lead to a Purchase Order by GRC and forms a one-time-service. This purchase order will be signed with German Red Cross headquarters based in Berlin and the services will be invoiced to <u>Deutsches Rotes Kreuz e.V., Carstennstr. 58, 12205 Berlin, Germany ;with tax ID number DE1221223471.</u>

9. Terms of delivery and payment

- 1) Unless explicitly permitted, GRC does not accept partial shipments.
- 2) The invoice must contain place of delivery and GRC order number.
- 3) Transport charges must be itemized separately.
- 4) Payment on invoice 30 days net, following receipt of goods and documents in order.
- 5) Payment to be done in Fresh USD (VAT as per official exchange rate)
- 6) Latest delivery date is November 20, 2022

10. Self-Declaration
