Introduction

Lebanon's Youth Building Dreams (LYBD) is a youth-led project that aims on establishing public spaces in 8 localities around Lebanon through the training of youth, called Dream Builders, who will take on the lead in advocating and creating public spaces for street sports and activating them by hosting free weekly street sports activities for local children.

This project is implemented by GAME and NAHNOO as the main implementing partners and is funded by the Danish International Development Agency, DANIDA, to strengthen social cohesion and civic engagement in Lebanon starting March 2021 until May 2023.

GAME Background

GAME is working for social change through youth-led street sports and culture in Africa, Europe, and the Middle East.

GAME establishes innovative facilities, offers youth-leader's trainings as coaches and role models in street sports and civil society and gives them the opportunity to use entrepreneurship to make positive changes for themselves and for peers and children.

GAME is a top 150 NGO with nearly 20 years of experience in lowering the threshold to the positive social communities of street sports and culture. Together with likeminded partners GAME is empowering children and youth from vulnerable areas and refugee settings.

Project Background

GAME establishes innovative facilities called **GAME House** and GAME Zones.

The goal is for street sports and street culture to be **accessible** to everyone. Here people can meet and engage in various activities and therefore **strengthen** the communities around street sports and the culture.

Involving the local communities is an important part of the process of building GAME Houses. Before and after the opening of the facilities, the users are invited to take part in several participatory workshops.

The GAME Houses and Zones strongly focus on sustainability in terms of reusing old buildings and materials for new functions. The urban street culture architecture complements the industrial history of the buildings with their raw and distinctive character and keeps the construction costs down compared to traditional indoor sports facilities.

GAME established 4 GAME Houses in Denmark, <u>Copenhagen</u>, <u>Esbjerg</u>, <u>Aalborg</u>, and <u>Viborg</u>.

GAME is now in the process of establishing a GAME mark, in <u>Karantina</u> Beirut, near the area of the Beirut blast.

Objective

GAME Lebanon is looking for a service provider to design and build a Public Street Sports Facility – an extension of GAME House Beirut as part of Lebanon's Youth Building Dreams project.

The <u>Karantina GAME Zone</u> will be an open facility, operated by GAME all year around.

Requirements

GAME is looking to add the following functions/modifications to the <u>existing</u> <u>building</u>:

- Storage room on the ground floor near the court area.
- Office Space (3 separate rooms) following the same plan as the current establishment on the ground floor.
- Refurbish existing bathrooms next to the office areas.
- Big meeting room on the first floor above the office area the meeting room should include 1 wall separation following the same plan as the current establishment.
- Closure of the open roof area with steel panels estimated area 450 m².
- Closure of all open sidewalls on all sides of the building shell with steel panels.
- Addition of doors between newly developed rooms and bathrooms.
- Refurbish the external door with steel plates in the area between the offices and storage room.
- Addition of a kitchen area under existing steel stairs include a sink, area for storage, and area for kitchen appliances.
- Salvage and repair all damaged steelworks across the facility when deemed possible.
- Install sufficient electrical outlets across all the facility, especially in the office area and building.
- Install sufficient lighting across all with their corresponding suitable wired connections.
- Wall painting for all newly refurbished rooms and existing concrete walls.
- Addition of safety foam pads (protection) across the building columns/pillars found in the court area foam height: 2 meters.
- Installing all needed sewage works for the facility and make sure it is well connected to a functional sewage system in the area.
- Floor refurbishment.
- All windows shall be installed with frames and glass closed with safety metal.

General Terms and Conditions

GAME will accept the most appropriate offer based on quality, expertise, costeffectiveness, and capacity for timely and flexible delivery.

GAME will not be liable for any costs or expenses incurred in the preparation of a tender or quotation.

Conflict of Interest

Any conflicts of interest involving an applicant must be fully disclosed to GAME. Failure to disclose a conflict may disqualify an application or invalidate an award of the contract.

Agreement Period

The agreement shall start from the date of awarding until 31st May 2023.
