INTRODUCTION TO Restart Center

The establishment of Restart Center, in 1996 in Tripoli region, emerged from the need to rebuild the lives of Torture and Trauma survivors in Lebanon and to restore the harm suffered by the victim whose dignity, health, mental health and self-sufficiency may not be fully recovered without the adequate, effective and comprehensive rehabilitation.

As of 1996 till date, Restart Center has been ensuring effective identification and access to rehabilitation for all victims of torture and ill-treatment throughout the provision of health, psychological, social and physical rehabilitation as well as legal services to victims of Torture, War Trauma and their families.

1. REQUIREMENTS

Restart Center for Rehabilitation of Victims of Violence and Tortureinvites qualified Vendorsto make a firm offer for the establishment of Frame Agreement(s) for, LABORATORY TESTS as listed in Annex A which sets out the exact technical requirements.

Restart Center is requesting all bidders to submit their quotes for each service separately.

Restart Center may award Frame Agreement(s) with initial duration of 1 year, potentially extendable for 1-year period subject to the satisfactory vendor's performance and availability of funds. The successful bidders will be requested to maintain their quoted price model for the duration of the Frame Agreement(s).

The tentative Monthly forecast below will enable bidders to have an indication of the projected requirements.:

1. Restart Monthly referrals for laboratory tests should not exceed 60 cases.

The above number does not represent a commitment that Restart will be referring the above number of patients but it provides a good indication of the monthly need. Numbers may vary and will depend on the actual requirements and funds available regulated by issuance of individual Doctor prescriptions and referral forms against the Frame Agreement.

It is strongly recommended that this Invitation to Bid document and its annexes be read thoroughly. Failure to observe the procedures laid out therein may result in disqualification from the evaluation process.

Note: This document is not construed in any way as an offer to contract with your firm.

Restart Center will compile the questions received and plan to respond to the questions shortly after the query closing date.

Restart Center may, at its discretion, copy any reply to a particular question to all other invited bidders at once.

4. YOUR OFFER:

Your offershall beprinted in English. if the offer is hand written it should be prepared using BLUE INK PEN

Your offer shall comprise the following twosets of documents in two different sealed envelopes:

- Technical offer- Annex A
- Financial offer-Annex B

Technical and financial offer must be sealed and stamped in TWO SEPERATE envelopes which then should be sealed and stamped in a third envelope. Offers not following this requirement may be disqualified.

Please submit your offer using the Annexes provided. Offers not conforming to the requested formats may be not taken into consideration.

IMPORTANT:

5. Content of the TECHNICAL OFFER:

IMPORTANT:

No pricing information should be included in the Technical offer. Failure to comply may risk disqualification. The technical offer should contain all information required.

Your technical offer should clearly state whether or not the tests you are offering are fully conforming to the specifications given. Clearly state and disclose any discrepancies with the specifications given.

The following details shall also be provided in the Technical Offer.

Test availability: The technical offer shall clearly indicate the tests quoted for in your offer (Annex A) and also if alternative is offered in any of the cases. Please note that full coverage of the tests indicated as Mandatory will be taken into consideration in the evaluation same as % of total test covered in your offer. Please submit Annex A both in Excel and Pdf versions.

Time required for results readiness: The suppliers are advised to provide a time frame required for the results to be out from the date of request- Annex A.

Daily capacity: Please indicate the laboratory capacity to receive patients on a daily basis- Annex A

Test completed In house or is subcontracted:in case the test is subcontracted, kindly provide the name and contact details of the subcontracted laboratory-Annex A

Laboratory Infrastructure:

Testing method and technique for each grouping (to be indicated in Annex A):

- > Testing method: The technical offer shall state the testing method and technique for each grouping
- Equipment brand name: The technical offer shall state the equipment band name.
- Manufacturer country of origin: The technical offer shall state the country in which the equipment is manufactured

- Laboratory agrees to send a specialized employee to Restart Center premises once a week to take blood from beneficiaries, in order to be analyzed.
- Laboratory agrees to repeatAny test result with doubt from Restart's doctors on the Laboratory cost.
- Laboratorywill contact Restart center immediately if patient results are alarming.

Any information that will facilitate our evaluation of your company's substantive reliability, financial and managerial capacity to provide the services.

Inspection: Inspection might be applicable. The inspection will be arranged and paid for by Restart. Please note that inspection charges resulting from the supplier's default will be charged directly to the supplier.

6. Content of the FINANCIALOFFER:

Your separateFinancial Offer must contain an overall offer in a single currency, in Lebanese Pound LBP. Bids that have a different price structure may not be accepted.

Unit costs: the bidder shall quote the unit price (per test) and discounts shall be clearly indicated.

Format: Use ONLY the attached Annex B Financial Offer (Price list) for submitting your quote .Please submit Annex B both in Excel and Pdf versions.

You are requested to hold your offer valid for 180days from the deadline for submission. Restart will make its best effort to select a company within this period. The pricing model quoted in the Supplier's offer will remain valid for the duration of the Frame Agreement. Restart's standard payment terms are within 30 days after satisfactory implementation and receipt of documents in order

7. BID EVALUATION:

The evaluation will be conducted in 2 stages as follows:

First Stage (Technical): Restart nominated technical evaluation committee will conduct the technical evaluation of the received offers, based on a pass/fail determination as listed in section 5, and whether the specification substantially conform to the request.

Second Stage (Financial): Bids will be tabulated and compared for all companies passing the technical evaluation. It is important to send a complete and detailed offer. The contract may be awarded to the vendor(s) with the lowest technically compliant offer.

IMPORTANT: The Financial offer will only be opened for evaluation if the supplier's technical part of the offer has passed the technical evaluation and has been accepted by Restart Center as meeting the technical specifications.
