B. GENERAL PROVISIONS

<p>1. Introduction</p>	<p>1.1 Bidders shall adhere to all the requirements of this ITB, including any amendments made in writing by PCPM. This ITB is conducted in accordance with the PCPM Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) on Contracts and Procurement.</p> <p>1.2 Any Bid submitted will be regarded as an offer by the Bidder and does not constitute or imply the acceptance of the Bid by PCPM. PCPM is under no obligation to award a contract to any Bidder as a result of this ITB.</p> <p>1.3 PCPM reserves the right to cancel the procurement process at any stage without any liability of any kind for PCPM, upon notice to the bidders.</p>
<p>2. Fraud & Corruption, Gifts and Hospitality</p>	<p>2.1 PCPM strictly enforces a policy of zero tolerance on proscribed practices, including fraud, corruption, collusion, unethical or unprofessional practices, and obstruction of PCPM vendors and requires all bidders/vendors to observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement process and contract implementation.</p> <p>2.2 Bidders/vendors shall not offer gifts or hospitality of any kind to PCPM staff members including recreational trips to sporting or cultural events, theme parks or offers of holidays, transportation, or invitations to extravagant lunches or dinners.</p> <p>2.3 In pursuance of this policy, PCPM:</p> <p>(a) Shall reject a bid if it determines that the selected bidder has engaged in any corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the contract in question;</p> <p>(b) Shall declare a vendor ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period, to be awarded a contract if at any time it determines that the vendor has engaged in any corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for, or in executing a PCPM contract.</p> <p>2.4 All Bidders must adhere to the UN Supplier Code of Conduct, which may be found at https://www.un.org/Depts/ptd/sites/www.un.org.Depts.ptd/files/files/attachment/page/pdf/unscc/conduct_english.pdf</p>
<p>3. Eligibility</p>	<p>3.1 A vendor should not be suspended, debarred, or otherwise identified as ineligible by any UN Organization or the World Bank Group or any other international Organization. Vendors are therefore required to disclose to PCPM whether they are subject to any sanction or temporary suspension imposed by these organizations.</p> <p>3.2 It is the Bidder's responsibility to ensure that its employees, joint venture members, sub-contractors, service providers, suppliers and/or their employees meet the eligibility requirements as established by PCPM.</p>
<p>4. Conflict of Interests</p>	<p>4.1 Bidders must strictly avoid conflicts with other assignments or their own interests, and act without consideration for future work. Bidders found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. Without limitation on the generality of the above, Bidders, and any of their affiliates, shall be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this solicitation process, if they:</p> <p>a) Are or have been associated in the past, with a firm or any of its affiliates which have been engaged by PCPM to provide services for the preparation of the design, specifications, Terms of Reference, cost analysis/estimation, and other documents to be used for the procurement of the goods and services in this selection process;</p> <p>b) Were involved in the preparation and/or design of the programme/project related to the goods and/or services requested under this ITB; or</p>

	<p>c) Are found to be in conflict for any other reason, as may be established by, or at the discretion of PCPM.</p> <p>4.2 In the event of any uncertainty in the interpretation of a potential conflict of interest, Bidders must disclose to PCPM, and seek PCPM’s confirmation on whether or not such conflict exists.</p> <p>4.3 Similarly, the Bidders must disclose in their Bid their knowledge of the following:</p> <p>a) If the owners, part-owners, officers, directors, controlling shareholders, of the bidding entity or key personnel who are family members of PCPM staff involved in the procurement functions and/or the Government of the country or any Implementing Partner receiving goods and/or services under this ITB; and</p> <p>b) All other circumstances that could potentially lead to actual or perceived conflict of interest, collusion or unfair competition practices.</p> <p>Failure to disclose such an information may result in the rejection of the Bid or Bids affected by the non-disclosure.</p>
C. PREPARATION OF BIDS	
5. General Considerations	<p>5.1 In preparing the Bid, the Bidder is expected to examine the ITB in detail. Material deficiencies in providing the information requested in the ITB may result in rejection of the Bid.</p> <p>5.2 The Bidder will not be permitted to take advantage of any errors or omissions in the ITB. Should such errors or omissions be discovered, the Bidder must notify the PCPM accordingly.</p>
6. Cost of Preparation of Bid	6.1 The Bidder shall bear all costs related to the preparation and/or submission of the Bid, regardless of whether their Bid is selected or not. PCPM shall not be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the procurement process.
7. Language	7.1 The Bid, as well as any and all related correspondence exchanged by the Bidder and PCPM, shall be written in the language (s) specified in the BDS (English).
8. Documents Comprising the Bid	8.1 The Bid shall comprise of the duly filled forms A-E found at the end of the present ITB and all specified attachments, including a risk matrix (on vendor’s own template) provided by the vendor to mitigate delays or changes related to the challenging context in Lebanon (fuel, electricity, items scarcity, transportation etc.) .
9. Documents Establishing the Eligibility and Qualifications of the Bidder	9.1 The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence of its status as an eligible and qualified vendor, using the Forms provided under Section 6 and providing documents required in those forms. In order to award a contract to a Bidder, its qualifications must be documented to PCPM’s satisfaction.
10. Delivery and Price Schedules	10.1 The Delivery Schedule and Price Schedule shall be prepared using the Form provided in Section 6 of the ITB and taking into consideration the requirements in the ITB.
11. Currencies	11.1 All prices shall be quoted in the currency of USD as indicated in the BDS.
12. Only One Bid	<p>12.1 The Bidder shall submit only one Bid, in its own name.</p> <p>12.2 Bids submitted by two (2) or more Bidders shall all be rejected if they are found to have any of the following:</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) they have at least one controlling partner, director or shareholder in common; or b) any one of them receive or have received any direct or indirect subsidy from the other/s; or c) they have the same legal representative for purposes of this ITB; or d) they have a relationship with each other, directly or through common third parties, that puts them in a position to have access to information about, or influence on the Bid of another Bidder regarding this ITB process; or e) they are subcontractors to each other's Bid, or a subcontractor to one Bid also submits another Bid under its name as lead Bidder; or some key personnel proposed to be in the team of one Bidder participates in more than one Bid received for this ITB process. This condition relating to the personnel, does not apply to subcontractors being included in more than one Bid.
13. Bid Validity Period	<p>13.1 Bids shall remain valid for the period specified in the BDS, commencing on the Deadline for Submission of Bids. A Bid valid for a shorter period may be rejected by PCPM and rendered non-responsive.</p> <p>13.2 During the Bid validity period, the Bidder shall maintain its original Bid without any change, including the availability of the Key Personnel, the proposed rates and the total price.</p>
14. Extension of Bid Validity Period	<p>14.1 In exceptional circumstances, prior to the expiration of the Bid validity period, PCPM may request Bidders to extend the period of validity of their Bids. The request and the responses shall be made in writing and shall be considered integral to the Bid.</p> <p>14.2 If the Bidder agrees to extend the validity of its Bid, it shall be done without any change to the original Bid.</p> <p>14.3 The Bidder has the right to refuse to extend the validity of its Bid, in which case, the Bid shall not be further evaluated.</p>
15. Clarification of Bid (from the Bidders)	<p>15.1 Bidders may request clarifications on any of the ITB documents no later than the date indicated in the BDS. Any request for clarification must be sent in writing in the manner indicated in the BDS. If inquiries are sent other than the specified channel, even if they are sent to a PCPM staff member, PCPM shall have no obligation to respond or confirm that the query was officially received.</p> <p>15.2 PCPM will provide the responses to clarifications through the method specified in the BDS.</p> <p>15.3 PCPM shall endeavour to provide responses to clarifications in an expeditious manner, but any delay in such response shall not cause an obligation on the part of PCPM to extend the submission date of the Bids, unless PCPM deems that such an extension is justified and necessary.</p>
16. Amendment of Bids B.	<p>16.1 At any time prior to the deadline of Bid submission, PCPM may for any reason, such as in response to a clarification requested by a Bidder, modify the ITB in the form of an amendment to the ITB. Amendments will be made available to all prospective bidders.</p> <p>16.2 If the amendment is substantial, PCPM may extend the Deadline for submission of Bid to give the Bidders reasonable time to incorporate the amendment into their Bids.</p>
17. Alternative Bids	17.1 Unless otherwise specified in the BDS, alternative Bids shall not be considered.

D. SUBMISSION AND OPENING OF BIDS

18. Submission	<p>18.1 The Bidder shall send a scan of a duly signed and complete Bid comprising the documents and forms in accordance with requirements in the BDS to the email address lebanon.procurement@pcpm.org.pl. The Bid shall be sent as a password-encrypted PDF file comprising all required forms and attachments. A password to the file shall only be sent upon the deadline for submissions in a separate email message from the same email address which was used to send the Bid itself.</p> <p>18.2 The Bid shall be signed by the Bidder or person(s) duly authorized to commit the Bidder. The authorization shall be communicated through a document evidencing such authorization issued by the legal representative of the bidding entity, or a Power of Attorney, accompanying the Bid.</p> <p>18.3 Bidders must be aware that the mere act of submission of a Bid, in and of itself, implies that the Bidder fully accepts the PCPM General Contract Terms and Conditions.</p>
19. Deadline for Submission of Bids and Late Bids	<p>19.1 Complete Bids must be received by PCPM in the manner, and no later than the date and time, specified in the BDS. PCPM shall only recognise the actual date and time that the bid was received by PCPM.</p> <p>19.2 PCPM shall not consider any Bid that is received after the deadline for the submission of Bids.</p>
20. Withdrawal, Substitution, and Modification of Bids	<p>20.1 A Bidder may withdraw, substitute or modify its Bid after it has been submitted at any time prior to the deadline for submission.</p> <p>20.2 A Bidder may withdraw, substitute or modify its Bid by sending a scan of a written notice to PCPM, duly signed by an authorized representative, and shall include a copy of the authorization (or a Power of Attorney). The corresponding substitution or modification of the Bid, if any, must accompany the respective written notice. All notices must be submitted in the same manner as specified for submission of Bids, by clearly marking them as “WITHDRAWAL” “SUBSTITUTION,” or “MODIFICATION”</p> <p>20.3 Bids requested to be withdrawn shall be deleted from PCPM’s hardwares and email inboxes.</p>
21. Bid Opening	<p>21.1 PCPM will open the Bid in the presence of an ad-hoc committee formed by PCPM of at least three (3) members.</p>

E. EVALUATION OF BIDS

22. Confidentiality	<p>22.1 Information relating to the examination, evaluation, and comparison of Bids, and the recommendation of contract award, shall not be disclosed to Bidders or any other persons not officially concerned with such process, even after publication of the contract award.</p> <p>22.2 Any effort by a Bidder or anyone on behalf of the Bidder to influence PCPM in the examination, evaluation and comparison of the Bids or contract award decisions may, at PCPM’s decision, result in the rejection of its Bid and may subsequently be subject to the application of prevailing PCPM’s vendor sanctions procedures.</p>
23. Evaluation of Bids	<p>23.1 PCPM will conduct the evaluation solely on the basis of the Bids received.</p> <p>23.2 Evaluation of Bids shall be undertaken in the following steps:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Preliminary Examination including Eligibility b) Arithmetical check and ranking of bidders who passed preliminary examination by price.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> c) Qualification assessment (if pre-qualification was not done) d) Evaluation of prices, delivery timeframe and reliability of a Bidder e) Quality assessment based on provided samples <p>Detailed evaluation will be focussed on the 3 to 5 lowest priced bids. Further higher priced bids shall be added for evaluation if necessary.</p>
24. Preliminary Examination	24.1 PCPM shall examine the Bids to determine whether they are complete with respect to minimum documentary requirements, whether the documents have been properly signed, and whether the Bids are generally in order, among other indicators that may be used at this stage. PCPM reserves the right to reject any Bid at this stage.
25. Evaluation of Eligibility and Qualification	<p>25.1 Eligibility and Qualification of the Bidder will be evaluated against the Minimum Eligibility/Qualification requirements specified in the Section 4 (Evaluation Criteria).</p> <p>25.2 In general terms, vendors that meet the following criteria may be considered qualified:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) They are not included in the UN Security Council 1267/1989 Committee's list of terrorists and terrorist financiers, and in UNDP's ineligible vendors' list; b) They have a good financial standing and have access to adequate financial resources to perform the contract and all existing commercial commitments, c) They have the necessary similar experience, technical expertise, production capacity, quality certifications, quality assurance procedures and other resources applicable to the supply of goods and/or services required; d) They are able to comply fully with the PCPM General Terms and Conditions of Contract; e) They do not have a consistent history of court/arbitral award decisions against the Bidder; and f) They have a record of timely and satisfactory performance with their clients.
26. Evaluation of Technical Bid and prices	26.1 The evaluation team shall review and evaluate the Bids on the basis of their responsiveness to the Schedule of Requirements and other documentation provided, applying the procedure indicated in the BDS and other ITB documents. When necessary, and if stated in the BDS, PCPM may invite technically responsive Bidders for a presentation related to their technical Bids. The conditions for the presentation shall be provided in the bid document where required.
27. Due diligence	<p>27.1 PCPM reserves the right to undertake a due diligence exercise, aimed at determining to its satisfaction, the validity of the information provided by the Bidder. Such exercise shall be fully documented and may include, but need not be limited to, all or any combination of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Verification of accuracy, correctness and authenticity of information provided by the Bidder; b) Validation of extent of compliance to the ITB requirements and evaluation criteria based on what has so far been found by the evaluation team; c) Inquiry and reference checking with Government entities with jurisdiction on the Bidder, or with previous clients, or any other entity that may have done business with the Bidder; d) Inquiry and reference checking with previous clients on the performance on on-going or completed contracts, including physical inspections of previous works, as deemed necessary; e) Physical inspection of the Bidder's offices, branches or other places where business transpires, with or without notice to the Bidder; f) Other means that PCPM may deem appropriate, at any stage within the selection process, prior to awarding the contract.

28. Clarification of Bids	<p>28.1 To assist in the examination, evaluation and comparison of Bids, PCPM may, at its discretion, request any Bidder for a clarification of its Bid.</p> <p>28.2 PCPM's request for clarification and the response shall be in writing and no change in the prices or substance of the Bid shall be sought, offered, or permitted, except to provide clarification, and confirm the correction of any arithmetic errors discovered by PCPM in the evaluation of the Bids, in accordance with the ITB.</p> <p>28.3 Any unsolicited clarification submitted by a Bidder in respect to its Bid, which is not a response to a request by PCPM, shall not be considered during the review and evaluation of the Bids.</p>
29. Collection of samples	<p>29.1 Upon evaluation in accordance with point 26.1 above, suppliers deemed prospective will be invited to provide samples of goods as listed in the Schedule of Requirements.</p> <p>29.2 PCPM reserves the right to contact only the selected suppliers who pass the Preliminary Examination, are eligible to participate in the Bid and offer competitive prices as well as a satisfactory delivery schedule.</p> <p>29.3 Assessment of provided samples will be done by the evaluation committee with possibility of including external experts to support the quality assessment. The goods will be assessed (each item in the sample, as listed in the Schedule of Requirements) and each sample will be graded based on a scoring matrix.</p>
F. AWARD OF CONTRACT	
30. Right to Accept, Reject, Any or All Bids	<p>30.1 PCPM reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to render any or all of the bids as non-responsive, and to reject all Bids at any time prior to award of contract, without incurring any liability, or obligation to inform the affected Bidder(s) of the grounds for PCPM's action. PCPM shall not be obliged to award the contract to the lowest priced offer.</p>
31. Award Criteria	<p>31.1 Prior to expiration of the period of Bid validity, PCPM shall award the contract to the qualified and eligible Bidder that is found to be responsive to the requirements of the Schedule of Requirements and Other Related Requirements, has offered the lowest price along with an acceptable time of delivery.</p>
32. Debriefing	<p>32.1 In the event that a Bidder is unsuccessful, the Bidder may request for a debriefing from PCPM. The purpose of the debriefing is to discuss the strengths and weaknesses of the Bidder's submission, in order to assist the Bidder in improving its future Bids for PCPM procurement opportunities. The content of other Bids and how they compare to the Bidder's submission shall not be discussed.</p>
33. Right to Vary Requirements at the Time of Award	<p>33.1 At the time of award of Contract, PCPM reserves the right to vary the quantity of goods and/or services, by up to a maximum forty per cent (40%) of the total offer, without any increase in the unit price or other terms and conditions.</p>
34. Contract Signature	<p>34.1 Within seven (7) days from the date of receipt of the Contract, the successful Bidder shall sign and date the Contract and return it to PCPM. Failure to do so may constitute sufficient ground for the annulment of the award, and on which event, PCPM may award the Contract to the Second highest rated or call for new Bids.</p>
35. Liquidated Damages	<p>35.1 PCPM shall apply Liquidated Damages for the damages and/or risks caused to PCPM resulting from the Contractor's delays or breach of its obligations as per Contract.</p>
36. Payment Provisions	<p>36.1 Payment conditions shall be governed by the Contract with a successful Bidder.</p>
