The Choral Trainer will play a role in fostering musical skills, enhancing vocal capabilities, and promoting a sense of teamwork and artistic expression among participants.

Objectives:

The objective of the choral training is to empower young individuals aged between 17 and 28 by providing comprehensive vocal training suitable for both those with prior knowledge and beginners. The training aims to develop musical skills, enhance vocal capabilities, and instill a sense of teamwork and artistic expression through engaging workshops. The recently designated public park in Al Mina - North Lebanon will serve as the dedicated space for choral training, creating an optimal environment for participants to explore and develop their musical talents.

Scope of Work

Duration and Schedule:

- The training program will span 8 days.
- Each workshop day will consist of 1.5 hours, resulting in a total of 12 training hours.

The Choral Trainer is expected to cover a diverse curriculum, including:

- Vocal warm-ups and techniques for beginners and advanced participants.
- Harmony and choral singing fundamentals.
- Interpretation of musical pieces and expressive singing.
- Team-building activities and collaborative musical projects.
- Performance preparation and stage presence

Role and Responsibility

The Choral Trainer is encouraged to use engaging and participatory training methods to foster a dynamic and interactive learning environment. This may include group singing, vocal exercises, ensemble practice, and Q&A sessions.

- Detailed workshop curriculum outline.
- Engaging and informative workshop sessions.
- In addition to facilitating the workshop, the selected trainer will be responsible for consolidating the insights, recommendations, and action plans generated during the workshop into one comprehensive report/document.

Qualifications:

- The applicant should have at least 2 years of relevant work experience in choral activities.
- Any recognized certifications in the mentioned services are a plus.

- The applicant should have good communication skills, empathy, and the ability to motivate individuals.
- Ability to multi-task and to work a flexible or alternative workweek schedule based on project needs.
- Availability to deliver the workshops starting the month of **Dec 2023**.

Evaluation Criteria:

The service provider will be selected based on:

- Relevant Work experience in the field, and portfolio.
- The financial proposal.
