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I. INTRODUCTION

A. ORGANIZATION BACKGROUND

The Lebanon Reforestation Initiative (LRI) is a Lebanese NGO registered at the Ministry of Interior and Municipalities under no. 1186 on 18 June 2014. The Lebanon Reforestation Initiative has transformed the way native trees are grown and planted in Lebanon and assisted diverse communities throughout the country to restore more than 1,300 hectares of communal forest lands by planting more than 1,200,000 native trees. It has established successful models of community-based landscape restoration, public-private funding mechanisms, and community wildfire prevention and management.

LRI is implementing a one-year urban forestry intervention under the United States Forest Service funded project "Strengthening Climate Change Resilience in Lebanon". The planting portion of interventions aims to increase green cover in Saida and strategically increase the ensuing ecosystem services. Based on site assessments and thorough site selection, LRI will be planting a section of around 10,000m2 near the coastal region with approximately 1000 seedlings.

II. PURPOSE

LRI is seeking a qualified urban forestry consultant/landscape designer with experience and knowledge of working in urban contexts to support LRI team in developing clear designs and recommendations for the planting interventions in Saida. Methods focused on accommodating community needs, increasing ecosystem services and using native tree species are preferred. The consultant is also requested to adhere to scheduled field visits during the implementation phase. The overall purpose is to strategically maximize the benefits resulting from the tree planting.

A. SCOPE OF WORK

The selected expert shall be part of a team that consists of LRI and local experts who will work jointly to develop the concept and implement the planting interventions for the aforementioned planting area. The consultant will take in consideration LRI's opinion in concept development but will be solely responsible for delivering a design map for the urban forestry interventions. The consultant will propose an implementation process for the landscaping work that will be set in coordination with LRI to meet project targets and workplan schedule. The consultant will assist LRI in the selection of trees in each of the sites.

The consultant needs to be flexible and adaptive and must allow for revisions of proposed designs.

B. DELIVERABLES



The consultant will be required to deliver the following:

- Develop concept proposal for selected location with concept and design justification. This proposal should identify a purpose and concept for the intended designs. The concept should relate to the location, identity local needs of the selected area in Saida. This deliverable requires preliminary designs with a detailed description of the concept that takes into consideration the project targets set by LRI. The preliminary concept may include larger scale master plan ideas for the area but the preliminary designs should reasonably and practically fit within the budget of the project.
- Landscape designs with design development drawings (Master plan of the entire project, Hardscape Plans Scale: 1/100, Softscape Plans Scale: 1/100, Elevations Scale: Variable, Softscape details Scale: Variable, Hardscape details Scale: Variable, Softscape & hardscape palette, Outdoor lighting plans (if needed) Scale: 1/50.
- BoQs for design-based purchases

IV. PROPOSAL PREPARATION AND SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

A. INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPOSAL PREPARATION

The selection committee will evaluate the Offerors based upon their written technical and cost proposals. Each section will be evaluated according to the criteria for evaluations in Section V. Offerors are expected to examine the specifications and all instructions in the RFP. Failure to do so is at the Offeror's risk. Interested Offerors must provide the following:

1. CAPABILITY AND TECHNICAL EXPERIENCE STATEMENT

Demonstrate capabilities and technical experience by providing the following:

- a. Clear CV
- b. Portfolio of previous work carried
- c. Proposal submitted in response to this RFP showing the approach and methodology to address the above deliverables
- d. Documentation to verify licensure (MOF registration certificate, etc.)



Offerors will submit a proposed budget with their proposals in a separate file, labeled "Budget Proposal." The proposed budget will have sufficient detail to allow evaluation of elements of costs proposed. Transportation / accommodation will be at the service provider's expense.

Cost proposal should show the number of days for every milestone and the fees for every day.

Budgets should be submitted in US Dollars; please label your budget with the name of the currency. LRI reserves the right to request any additional information to support detailed cost and price.

Payment Terms:

- All invoices should be stamped with a LBP 250 stamp as per MOF regulations.
- Non-Registered suppliers will be subject to taxes deduction on payment settlement 7.5% for services as per Lebanese MOF regulations.
- Payments are processed via (a) wire transfer, (b) check or (c) telegraphic transfer to the beneficiary
- In case of telegraphic transfers, please provide us with the name of the person who will be collecting the funds, his phone number, photo of ID as well as preferred Bank Audi branch
- For cumulative payments up to USD 3,000, LRI can issue telegraphic transfers to suppliers with fees that the vendor approves to bare
- For amounts exceeding USD 3,000, payments will be processed via wire transfers to fresh accounts
- Wire transfers to external accounts in Bank Audi are free of charge as for transfers to any other bank, fees will be shared between both parties
- VAT amount is paid in LBP at the official exchange rate set by BDL.
- Payments will be issued within 15 to 30 days from date of invoice acceptance
- Checks will be issued to the order of the beneficiary as stated in the invoice ONLY
- Lost or misplaced checks by suppliers will not be replaced

3. Lebanon Reforestation Initiative will not compensate Offerors for their preparation of responses to this RFP.

V. CRITERIA FOR EVALUATION

LRI will evaluate proposals based on a best-value determination; Offerors should submit their most competitive price proposal. Proposals will be evaluated using the following criteria:

- A degree in Architecture, urban planning or landscape designing 10%
- Previous urban planning experience, landscape designing is a plus –20%
- Proposed budget 30%
- Schedule availability 30%
- Impactful CV/previous references 10%

The evaluation committee will review the technical proposal based upon the technical criteria listed above. The cost proposals will be reviewed to ensure they are complete and free of computational errors. The committee will also assess the reasonableness of costs and the cost-effectiveness of the budget and will determine whether the costs reflect a clear understanding of project requirements. A contract will be offered to the responsible Service Provider whose proposal follows the RFP instructions and is judged to be the most advantageous to LRI.

VI. SOLICITATION PROCESS

Once the RFP is released, the Offerors must prepare a formal proposal to be sent to the contact person at LRI as indicated in Section IV (b) (1). The submitted proposals will be reviewed against the criteria for evaluation defined in Section V



above and rated on their ability to satisfy the requirements stated in this RFP document. A preferred service provider will be chosen and formally notified. A formal contract will be negotiated with the selected service provider and, if endorsed, the Offeror will begin work on the project.

VII. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

A. LATE SUBMISSIONS

Proposals received after the submission deadline stated in the cover page of this RFP may not be considered. Offerors will be held responsible for ensuring their quotations are received according to the instructions stated herein. A late offer will be considered if the cause was attributable to LRI or its employees/agents, or if it is in the best interest of LRI.

B. MODIFICATION OF RFP REQUIREMENTS

LRI retains the right to terminate the RFP or modify the requirements upon notification to Offerors.

C. WITHDRAWALS OF PROPOSALS

Proposals may be withdrawn by written notice via email at any time before award. Proposals may be withdrawn in person by an Offeror or authorized representative, if the representative's identity is made known and the representative signs a receipt for the proposal before award.

D. RIGHT OF NEGOTIATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF PROPOSAL

This RFP represents a definition of requirements and is an invitation for submission of proposals. LRI reserves the right to fund/award any or none of the submitted proposals. No commitment is made, either expressed or implied, to compensate Offerors for costs incurred in the preparation and submission of their proposal.

LRI may reject any proposal that is nonresponsive. A responsive proposal is one that complies with all terms and conditions of the RFP. A proposal must be complete, signed by an authorized signatory, and delivered no later than the submission time and date indicated on the cover sheet of this RFP. LRI may reserve the right to waive any minor discrepancies in a proposal.

LRI reserves the right to issue an award based on the initial evaluation of proposals without discussion. LRI also reserves the right to enter into best and final negotiations with any responsive Offerors for all or part of the proposed scope.

E. VALIDITY OF PROPOSAL

Proposals submitted shall remain open for acceptance for *60 days* from the last date specified for receipt of proposals. This includes, but is not limited to, pricing, terms and conditions, service levels, and all other information. If your organization is awarded the contract, all information in the RFP and negotiation process is contractually binding.

F. MINIMUM OFFEROR QUALIFICATIONS

Offerors submitting proposals must (1) be officially licensed to do such business in *Lebanon*, (2) be able to receive USAID funds and (3) not have been identified as a terrorist. In addition, Offeror may be required to provide the following information:



- Documentation to verify licensure (e.g., tax id, registration certificate, etc.)
- Demonstration of adequate management to perform the contract
- Satisfactory records of performance history, integrity and business ethics

G. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

All tangible or intangible property created or acquired under this contract shall be the exclusive property of LRI and the donor. The term "property" includes all data and reports associated with this engagement. Reference is made to Sections 12 and 13 in the business terms and conditions attached in Appendix A.
