In addition to that, it aims to increase awareness among parents, caregivers, and community members about child protection issues, including identifying and reporting child abuse and exploitation. Simultaneously, the project will strengthen the capacity of child protection services to prevent, identify, and respond to cases of child abuse and exploitation.
