Objectives:

The objective is to offer a thorough and inclusive training program in handicrafts to both men and women in the above areas. The project's focus is to provide participants with detailed instruction covering all aspects of handcrafts, with the ultimate goal of empowering them to acquire proficiency in this craft.



Scope of Work:

The training is divided into six classes, each accommodating approximately 15 participants (Details in the above table)

- Curriculum Development: Develop a comprehensive and structured curriculum for the handcrafts training program. The curriculum should cover various techniques, tools, materials, and project-based learning activities. It should be tailored to different skill levels, from beginners to advanced learners.
- Training Materials and Resources: The trainer should create training materials and resources necessary for the program. This may include instructional guides, handouts, visual aids, samples, and other supporting materials.
- Training Sessions: These sessions should be interactive, hands-on, and engaging, allowing participants to practice and refine their skills.

Role and Responsibility:

The handcraft Trainer will be responsible for preparing and administering the training material of the handcraft training curriculum in compliance with the project objectives and timeline. Moreover, the handcraft Trainer will be responsible for reporting on the training progress and overall performance in a in a timely manner.

- Prepare and develop the training curriculum, exercises, and pre/post assessments content.
- Administer the training curriculum within the agreed-upon project timeline.
- Work closely with the project team to ensure a smooth implementation of the training curriculum in specific and the project in general.
- Follow up with project participants on their individual progress.
- Conduct a brainstorming session with the participants to agree on a product to be produced as a final project of the participants.

Deliverables:

In addition to facilitating the workshop, the selected trainer will be responsible for consolidating the insights, recommendations, and action plans generated during the workshop into one comprehensive report/document.

The report should include the following:

Qualifications:

- The applicant should have a certificate in handcraft education.



- The applicant should have at least 2 years of relevant work experience as handcraft Instructor.
- The applicant should have good communication skills, empathy, and the ability to motivate individuals.
- Ability to multi-task and to work a flexible or alternative workweek schedule based on project needs.
- Availability to deliver the workshops starting the month of **October.**

Evaluation Criteria:

The service provider will be selected based on:

- Qualifications.
- The financial proposal.
