Objectives

The objective of this project is to provide comprehensive sewing training to men and women residing in the Tripoli area. By offering detailed instruction in all aspects of sewing, the project empowers participants with the necessary skills and knowledge to become proficient in this craft. Additionally, the project aims to foster inclusivity by welcoming individuals. It recognizes the diversity within the community and provides an opportunity for people from different backgrounds to come together, learn from each other, and develop a shared passion for sewing.

Scope of Work

5 Classes, 6 sessions for each cycle, 3 times per week, 3 hours per session.

The instructor will be responsible for giving the following topics:

- Advanced Pattern Reading and Alterations: Making adjustments for different body types.
- Introduction to Garment Construction: Techniques for constructing sleeves, collars, and cuffs.
- Precision Sewing Techniques: Mastering intricate stitches and seam finishes on specific machines.
- Introduction to Sewing Machines: Techniques for high-volume production.
- Advanced Alterations and Tailoring: Alterations for more complex garments / Understanding garment structure for effective alteration

Role and Responsibility

The Sewing Instructor will be responsible for preparing and administering the training material for the Tailoring training curriculum in compliance with the project objectives and timeline. Moreover, the Sewing Instructor will be responsible for reporting on the training progress and overall performance on time

- Prepare and develop the training curriculum
- Administer the training curriculum within the agreed-upon project timeline
- Work closely with the project team to ensure a smooth implementation of the training curriculum in specific and the project in general.
- Follow up with project participants on their progress.
- Submit a final report that summarizes the outcome of the administered training.
- Conduct a brainstorming session with the participants to agree on a product to be produced as a final project of the participants.

In addition to facilitating the training, the selected Instructor will be responsible for consolidating the insights, recommendations, and action plans generated during the workshop into one comprehensive report/document.

Qualifications:

- The applicant should have a certificate in education (Sewing)
- The applicant should have at least 2 years of relevant work experience.
- Any recognized certifications in sewing are a plus.
- The applicant should have good communication skills, empathy, and the ability to motivate individuals.
- Ability to multi-task and to work a flexible or alternative workweek schedule based on project needs.
- Availability to deliver the workshops until the end of January 2024.

- The financial proposal.
