

Monthly Achievements

Shelter/NFI Cluster members are actively responding to the needs of displaced persons in northwest Syria, serving both newly displaced and long-term internally displaced persons (IDPs).

In February 2025, the team provided NFI assistance to over **30,226** individuals through core and winter NFI kits, including cash assistance.

The team also met the shelter needs of over **1,710** individuals in January through IDP site infrastructure improvements, dignified shelter construction, emergency shelter provision, and rehabilitation of damaged or unfinished shelters.

IDP Intention Survey (IIS) Results from CCCM Cluster

The IDP Intention Survey was conducted between January 26 and February 23, 2025, in northwest Syria (NWS). The assessment was coordinated by CCCM Cluster, UNHCR, and REACH to understand IDPs' return movement intentions, timelines, and influencing factors.

Key Movement Intentions

- Half of the 29,955 IDPs sampled plan to return to areas of origin within one year, potentially resulting in nearly one million returnees between 2025-2026
- Over 600,000 individuals expected to return before summer 2025
- About one-third intend to remain in current locations

Priority Areas of Return

Districts with highest return intentions:

- Idleb (65% of IDPs)
- Jebel Samaan (57% of IDPs)
- Harim (55% of IDPs)

Key geographic implications:

- 95% of returns projected within NWS and surrounding areas
- 40 times expected increase in population in Ma'aret Al Nu'man and Kafr Nobol sub-district (3,000 to 130,000)
- 23 sub-districts could experience at least doubled populations

Challenges and Considerations

- 80% of returnees report severely damaged or destroyed homes
- Female-headed households show different patterns: 55% are undecided or prefer to stay in displacement sites
- Main reasons for staying in current locations:
- Access to basic services (55%)
- Availability of affordable housing (41%)
- Access to humanitarian assistance (39%)



Core and essential NFI distribution


